RECOGNIZED VARIETIES



BLACK—Jet black surface color, very glossy with color deep down the hair shaft..



BLUE- Dark blue surface color, very glossy with color deep down the hair shaft..



BROKEN- Any color variety of the breed in a pattern with white. Color is the same glossiness as the variety description. The newest Havana variety.



CHOCOLATE- Very dark , glossy, chocolate brown, dark as the color of bittersweet chocolate with color deep down the hair shaft. The original Havana variety.

The Mink of the Rabbit Family

The Mink of the Rabbit Family

Havanas are known for their unique fur structure that makes them “The Mink of the Rabbit Family.” The fur is to be soft, dense, and lustrous with medium length, guard hairs are to be slightly coarser in texture with lots of luster. The coat is to carry a luster that gives it that glossy appearance.

Showing Havana

Havanas are to be rather short and compact, tapering slightly from the hindquarters to the shoulders. Shoulders and mid-section should be well rounded and well filled. The top body line should be a smooth continuous curve starting at the ear base and rising gradually to a high point over the center of the hips, then falling in a smooth curve downward to the base of the tail. The back, loin, and hind-quarters are to be full, smooth, and well rounded.
